^{**} The blue core brush is used to distuinguish it from the black core one when doing lead-free and leaded soldering.



Changing Brushes

1. Unplug from the mains and lift off the splashguard.



2. Lift up the white piece to remove the brushes.



3. Remove the tin collection tray for cleaning. Once clean, return it followed by the new brushes.
